

## GREEN PHASE

### In Person Worship Sundays at 10:00 AM

- We will follow CDC and State guidelines
- We will attempt to worship outdoors for as long as possible. Worship will take place in the rear of the church.
- Communion will be pre-poured grape juice and wafer cups and will be handed out at the beginning of the service with bulletins.
- Passing of the peace will be a small bow or incline of the head with hands to the heart
- Offering plates will not be passed. Offering can be left in the plate or receptacle specified upon entering or exiting the sanctuary or contributions can be made online.
- Masks are required when arriving at worship and if our worship service remains outdoors can be removed once you are seated and social distancing is practiced. Masks are required to be worn inside the building.
- The church nursery will NOT be open.
- As we continue to care for the most vulnerable among us, if you have been feeling ill or showing signs of illness, please refrain from attending the service until you have been symptom free for at least 14 days.

### In Door – In Person Worship

If the weather forces us indoors, we will follow these guidelines and adhere to the same guidelines for in person worship stated above.

- Worship Sign UP - Starting in October we will need all persons planning on coming to worship to sign up. You can call the church office or use the online sign up link attached to our worship emails and our website homepage. Of course you can still come to worship if you didn't have the chance to sign up, but please understand that we only allow the building to reach 50% occupancy and with worship taking place in the Fellowship Hall that will be limited to no more than 65 people.
- Wearing Masks - Masks are required to be worn inside the building and must stay on during worship.
- As a soft opening, when indoor worship is necessary it will take place in the Fellowship Hall. The reason for starting in the Fellowship Hall is because the Sanctuary painting project will start in October. The doors to the church will be opened no more than 10 minutes prior to the start of worship and people will be asked to sit in family groups.
- Doors will be marked for entering and exiting the building. Please use the appropriate door.

### Online Worship at 11:00am

- The Worship Service will be available at 11:00am on FacebookLive, Zoom, and Youtube

### Sunday School

- Sunday school will continue to be virtual until the 2021 calendar year.

#### Zoom Bible Study/Prayer Meeting - Wednesday at 10 AM

- If there is continued interest, this online Bible Study will continue to be offered.
- Open to all, participation via Zoom

#### Outreach Ministries (Laundry Love, Food Pantry, etc.)

- Continue normal schedule
- Volunteers may voluntarily wear masks and maintain 6-foot distance

#### Church Operations

- Office hours: Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday 9:00am to 3:00pm.
- Church committees can meet in the building or continue to meet via Zoom. Masks need to be worn when entering and exiting the building and when social distancing can not be met.
- Building cleaning: Coverall Cleaning Solutions will continue to clean the building on Friday night, and work on cleaning the entire building.
